Susanne Rischpler, Martin Haltrich, Codex 5393 of the Austrian National Library and its Local Context. A Synopsis (p. 307–320)

Up to now, Austrian National Library Codex 5393 has been used in research mainly for the mnemonic treatise *Iste ymagines sunt posite* and the cycle of mnemonic drawings contained in its penultimate quire. This paper deals with the other, much more comprehensive part of the manuscript, consisting of approximately 340 folia with documents regarding the councils of Pisa, Constance and Basel and offering valuable evidence for its provenance and dating, as well as interesting information concerning ecclesiastical and political history. The charterhouse of Gaming plays an important role, as does one of its priors, Leonhard II. Petraer († 1435), who was a counsellor of duke Albert V and acted as a visitor for the monastic reform movement of Melk.
