

Günter Katzler, A fragment of a medieval necrology from the Augustinian canonry of St. Georgen-Herzogenburg (p. 298–324)

The archive of the Augustinian canonry of St. Georgen-Herzogenburg in Lower Austria keeps the fragment of a necrology, which has been little known to the scientific community up to now. Form and content suggest that its entries can be dated between the early 13th and the beginning of the 15th century. Since all the other necrologies preserved in the canonry are early modern, the fragment is of considerable importance for investigating its medieval history. Starting with a detailed description of the source, the paper deals with issues such as local and wider personal networks, commemoration of the dead, and prayer confraternities of St. Georgen-Herzogenburg. A critical and annotated edition of the fragment is included.
