Tobias Daniels, The reception of Enea Silvio Piccolomini's writings at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Vienna. Biblioteca Capitolare di Trento, Ms. 86 (p. 418–424)

The paper analyses Ms. 86 of the Biblioteca Capitolare di Trento, containing treatises by Enea Silvio Piccolomini, and identifies one of the scribes, Johannes Lachel de Otting. He studied and taught at the university of Vienna, where he got access to the humanist's works, some of which he copied into the manuscript. He even entered a short excerpt from *De dieta Ratisponensi*, which is edited here. Lachel's manuscript indicates that Enea's writings were read and copied in Vienna more widely than hitherto known.
