

Irmgard Becker, Post-graduate apprenticeship as civil servant versus graduate master studies. The training of academic archivists in Germany and Austria (p. 154–162)

Whereas the post-graduate training of academic archivists in Germany looks back on a long tradition, archivists in Austria were trained in a course of study running parallel to university studies, which by now has become a master program. The curricula differ by a higher degree of practical and managerial contents in Marburg as against a greater focus on auxiliary sciences in Vienna. In Austria the training is part of and competing with university master programs. In Germany it follows administrative traditions of civil service which have not yet been adapted to the Bologna process.
