

Andrea Sommerlechner, *Processus negotii Raimundi comitis Tolosani* – remarks on insertions in the 12th volume of the registers of Pope Innocent III. (p. 139–145)

Volume 12 (1209/1210) of the registers of Pope Innocent III contains two insertions entitled *Processus negotii R(aimundi), comitis Tolosani* and *Forma iuramenti baronum, civitatum aliorumque locorum domino pape danda*. These two dossiers make up the report of the papal notary and legate Milo, consisting of 28 documents and two letters addressed to the pope, in which the legate gives account of his successes in the *negotium pacis et fidei* in Southern France and especially of his proceedings against count Raymond VI of Toulouse. Although formally disturbing the normal process of registration, in their contents they are testimony to the regular exchange between pope and legate.
