

Jürgen Petersohn, Emperor Frederick III supplies a political supporter with ecclesiastical prebends. Antonio Gratiadei as abbot of St Trudpert monastery. With an edition of sources (p. 433–436)

Based on hitherto unknown sources, the paper presents efforts of Emperor Frederick III in 1483 to establish his political supporter Antonio Gratiadei as abbot of the Benedictine abbey of St. Trudpert situated in the southern Black Forest in Germany, which were ultimately unsuccessful due to the opposition of Archduke Siegmund of Tirol.
