

Christoph Egger, Recently discovered manuscripts of early scholastic theological texts in Austrian libraries (p. 99–106)

The manuscript tradition of texts of early scholastic theology in Austrian libraries is particularly rich and testifies to an intense early reception of the works of authors like Peter Abelard and Gilbert of Poitiers. This article adds to the picture by presenting three hitherto unnoticed manuscripts of the sentence collection *Potest queri quid sit peccatum* (School of Laon, in Heiligenkreuz, Stiftsbibliothek Cod. 115 and Göttweig, Stiftsbibliothek Cod. 90 [13]) and of a fragmentary text of Abelard's *Theologia „Scholarium“* (Vienna, ÖNB Cod. 1050).
