

Katharina Kaska, Divided and destroyed: On a fragment of the *Magnum Legendarium Austriacum* in Heiligenkreuz (p. 91–98)

In this paper a late 12th-century fragment of the *Gesta Silvestri* which was used as the binding of a collection of 16th-century printed booklets in the library of the Cistercian abbey of Heiligenkreuz (Lower Austria) is attributed to the *Magnum Legendarium Austriacum* by codicological, palaeographical and textual comparisons. Together with documents on the monastery's book collection from the 14th and 15th century, it sheds light on the fragmentation, destruction and re-use of parts of this famous legendary in Heiligenkreuz.
