

Winfried Stelzer, Sundarheri. Ein frühkarolingisches Graffito um 800 in der Ringkrypta von St. Emmeram in Regensburg – das bisher älteste Graffito eines Personennamens im deutschen Sprachraum

Abstract: The graffito „Sundarheri“ in the annular crypt of the church of St. Emmeram in Regensburg, which can be palaeographically dated to c. 800, was written with high probability by the deacon Sundarheri of Freising. It is the earliest known graffito featuring a personal name in the German-speaking area.
