Abstract: The Maximiliana in the Haus-, Hof- und Staatsarchiv in Vienna. The archival collection and its cataloguing in times of the COVID pandemic

The Maximiliana in the Haus-, Hof- und Staatsarchiv comprise a colourful spectrum of documents from the years 1477–1519, whose unifying bond is their temporal and content-related reference to the Habsburg ruler Maximilian I (1459–1519). This article addresses in detail the developing archival history of the collection. It also provides a working report on the indexing of its individual items which had been only partially indexed by then in the years 2020–2021. The presentation of the description data combined with digital copies of the individual documents via the online archive information system of the Austrian State Archives makes this an essential collection for the history of Maximilian I and his time accessible from any location and at any time.
