

Matthias M. Tischler, Das Homiliar des Paulus Diaconus an der südwesteuropäischen Peripherie des Karolingerreiches

**Abstract:** The Homiliary of Paul the Deacon on the South Western European Periphery of the Carolingian empire. Methodological notes and additions to the content of a new monograph. The new publication of a study on the textual history, transmission and significance of the Homiliary of Paul the Deacon, one of the oldest collections of homilies from the early Carolingian period, gives reason to rethink the methodological approach of such a complex manuscript and textual history. In addition the article points out gaps and deals in particular with the hitherto neglected or unknown history of the transmission and impact of the work in the Iberian Peninsula, especially in Catalonia.
