

Markus Jeitler, *wir sind recht gemütlich und ungenirt*. Studien zum „alltäglichen Zeremoniell“ am Wiener Hof um 1800

Abstract: *we are quite comfortable and relaxed* – Studies on the „everyday ceremonial“ at the Viennese Court around 1800.

Ceremonial at the Viennese Imperial Court underwent a supposed transformation in the period around 1800, which was determined by various external and internal factors. While the court or state ceremonial was still strictly observed, hardly any regulations are known for the „everyday ceremonial“. Therefore the question is to what extent the „ceremonial“ extended deep into simple daily life, was regarded as courtly routine, and to what extent the „Biedermeier-familiar“ idyll can actually be discerned. For this purpose, various written sources such as ceremonial protocols, courtly reports and correspondence from the period 1804 to 1811 are examined in order to determine the difference between „official“ and „private“ occasions and events.
